What is our heart's loyalty? In today's Gospel, the Pharisees attempt to trap Jesus by asking about the obligation of paying taxes to the emperor. They know that if Jesus says that taxes should be paid, he would show a loyalty to another authority over their religious authority. But Jesus does not answer as they expect.

"Give...to God the things that are God's." Jesus' answer helps us reflect on loyalties in a new light. What are the things that are God's? Our hearts are made to seek and to glorify God. Our lives are God's! The path of faith is to discover what things we are giving priority to in our lives and to intentionally set God ahead of all of them. We put obstacles in our spiritual path whenever we set anything above seeking God in the heart of the Gospel and placing God first in our hearts.

So how do we clear away the obstacles from our path? We acknowledge that the "things that are God's" are all things. We owe God our very hearts, first and foremost, uncluttered by attachments. When something else comes first before God, we have placed ourselves as the first priority. Seeking to discover how our priorities are not first rooted in trust and gratitude for God helps to loosen their hold on us.

THE SPIRIT OF JOY

And it asked the question, are you a joyful Christian? Are you a joyful follower of Christ? Are you a joyful person? How would you answer?

This weekend, the first reading taken from the Prophet Isaiah, chapter 15, verse twenty five six speaks of a banquet, a party, and it goes like this. "On this mountain, the Lord will provide for us a banquet of rich food and choice wines, juicy rich food and pure choice wines."

Of course, every Sunday we celebrate the Lord's resurrection. So my question is, do we approach church with that celebratory spirit, with joy in our hearts? Or has church become a mere routine for us?

Let us pray for joy in our hearts as we approach our weekend celebration.
