

Proclamation of the Good News can be a challenge, but it is a risk that we must undertake with the hopeful assurance that the Father will indeed honour you. Verse twenty-seven of the Gospel passage speaks volumes. Elements of trust, hope and courage are all encompassed into one, which then strengthens one to declare: "Father, glorify your name." The readings from both the Book of Jeremiah and Paul's Letter to the Hebrews portray the image of God and His children. Together, the three readings ought to be an assurance that our lives through the Son is worth each breath. Our misgivings and imperfections are perfected through Him who truly knows the Father. The cited verse reminds me of Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane, and Christ Crucified. While His obedience shaped Him to be the ideal example for our sake, these two instances are crucial for each one of us as its alright to be dubious of what we're called towards. Hesitation will grab hold of us as we are in the moment but what matters most is that we channel our Spirit-induced boldness to let His will be done through us. It is never easy to do so but the Church and her people have endured persecution by modelling Jesus as our guide. As a matter of fact, to be a Christian is to be a follower of Christ, through whom the Father had been made known to us. This Lenten season, let us pray for the willingness to share in Christ's passion with the conscious knowledge of the eternal salvation that awaits us.




PARISH LENTEN MISSION


