

"My Lord and my God!" - John 20:28

St. Thomas' the Apostle's exclamation upon realizing that it was indeed Christ Himself before him, echoes the centurion's cry by the foot of the Cross. A Roman soldier, Holy Martyr Longinus the Centurion gave witness to the final moments of Jesus' earthly life. Church tradition believes that the soldier who pierced Christ's side with a spear was Longinus; the blood and water that came forth from His wound cured the soldier's eye affliction. All that he witnessed on that dire day lead Longinus to openly profess that "Truly this was the Son of God" (Mt. 27:54).

Both Longinus and Thomas needed to see Jesus' humanity and divinity. They knew that He was human and more; the blood and water that poured out from His side wound is indicative of Jesus' decision to empty Himself entirely to God's divine will (kenosis). The centurion, at the foot of the Cross, and the Apostle, with the Risen Lord, declared a firm and complete faith after witnessing both the human and divine in Jesus. Having confirmed their belief in Jesus, both men were filled with such vigour that Longinus the Centurion went north to his hometown of Cappadocia, while Thomas the Apostle travelled far to the East, all the while proclaiming the mystery of Jesus' salvific Death and Resurrection. Today, we rely on the same Spirit that inspired both these men, to help us understand this Christian mystery. That what began since the women came upon Jesus' missing body at the tomb has continued for twenty centuries – our unfailing testimony to the risen Christ. While we may not have seen Him in flesh, we make use of the sacraments and liturgy, life stories of martyrs and saints, but most of all divine Grace to help us remain grounded in our profession of the Christian faith. Much like the saints and martyrs long gone before us, we continue to muster the confidence to cry out "My Lord and my God" in our daily vocations.

"STAY AT HOME ORDER" EFFECTIVE APRIL 8, 2021

The announcement does not change current restrictions for places of worship. All regions of the Archdiocese of Toronto should continue with the following guidelines:

- Attendance is limited to 15% capacity of the worship space (including those assisting - priest, cantor, etc.) for sacramental celebrations, with the exception of funerals (see below). Physical distancing muust be observed at all times.
- Funerals are limited to 50 people (including those assisting but not including funeral home staff) per direction from the Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO). Parishes should liaise with funeral homes prior to making arrangements with families for additional clarity.

As of March 15th the regulations for places of Worship in the Gray Zone were changed to allow 15% capacity attendance at in perfor Mass son services (Masses). Given this information we have decided to do Online Regis-

tration ONLY for Weekend Masses with the capacity of 100 persons. Weekday Masses will be on a first come first serve basis. The link for the following Sunday Masses will be posted but not active until Saturdays at 12 midnight.


