And so Dominic looked to that simple way of praying and beseeching God, accessible to all and wholly pious, which is called the Rosary, or Psalter of the Blessed Virgin Mary, in which the same most Blessed Virgin is venerated by the angelic greeting repeated one hundred and fifty times, that is, according to the number of the Davidic Psalter, and by the Lord's Prayer with each decade. Interposed with these prayers are certain meditations showing forth the entire life of Our Lord Jesus Christ, thus completing the method of prayer devised by the Fathers of the Holy Roman Church.

- St. Pius V (1504-1572)

On October 7, the Church celebrates the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. In the year 1571, the epoch-shaping and history-shifting Battle of Lepanto took place. Fought by a growing and numerically superior Islamic fleet, the alliance of Christian vessels were able to rout the threat of advancing forces upon Europe. St. Pius V appreciated that the odds for military success were slim. The pressure being placed upon him was enormous. Not only did he feel the danger of a holy war from the Arab world, but the Protestant upheaval was sweeping through Northern Europe. St. Pius V's response was to plead for all Catholics to entrust the Churches' desperate need to our Blessed Mother. He ordered all Christian naval combatants to go to confession, receive holy communion and pray the rosary. Apparently, trust in our Blessed Mother was so strong that the recently gifted miraculous image of Our Lady of Guadalupe (1531) led the Christian ships into battle.

Whatever trial the Church or we as individuals are staring down, the Rosary is our choice defense at repelling an attack.


