Born in 1951, small town Wisconsin, the son of an Irish father and Italian mother, Fr. Robert McTeigue speaks of his normal, middle-class American upbringing, although, throughout his childhood, he struggled with shyness and a speech impediment. His vocation to the Jesuits, his subsequent healing and education, has now transformed him to a powerful, credible and reassuring voice to many.

With his 20 years of battled-tested experience as a university professor, he is excellent at thinking on his feet. He has written numerous books on philosophy and preaching. He hosts a popular radio program/podcast, titled, "The Catholic Current." He tackles controversial topics but does not seek to be provocative or inflammatory. His soothing voice and keen intellect allow for the art of mature conversation where important issues in the world of religion, culture and politics can be discussed. His daily program helps to fill the void left from main stream media. There are great benefits in listening; one need not feel isolated. As evidenced by the cited quote, the listener is assisted in helping to think and pray deeply on issues of concern that affect us all.

This weekend the readings fairly explode with joy and excitement, they reveal the true identity of our redeemer. He is, as today's First Reading says, the "ruler . . . whose origin is from . . . ancient times."
