Even if one is not a fan of mixing professional sports with faith, the discipline and competitiveness of Tom Brady has to be regarded as a model of imitation for any person looking to make strides in the world. His legendary work ethic – a daily bedtime of 8.30 p.m., his strict nutrition focused diet, his commitment to exercise, his readiness to be coached and taught, his commitment to his team mates...it is hard not to argue with his proven and much-heralded results.

The contending with all obstacles while on a journey towards greatness, glory and triumph is at the heart of our Christian faith.
