Accompany letter to Summorum Pontificum, July 2007

On February 22, the Church celebrates the liturgical feast of the Chair of St. Peter. The theology surrounding the mission of the Papacy is rooted in the gospels by Jesus' very clear and familiar instructions: "upon this rock I will build my Church", (Mt 16.18), "I have prayed for you that your own faith may not fail; and you, when once you have turned back, strengthen your brothers." (Lk 22.32) Accordingly then, the ministry of the one who occupies the Chair of St. Peter is to preserve the faith contained in the correct confession that "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." (Mt. 16,16), to confirm others in that faith, and to be a focal point of charitable unity.

What we are witnessing in our own day is something puzzlingly bizarre. Whatever one's experience or opinion regarding the Traditional Latin Mass, it is difficult to argue against Pope Benedict XVI's statement. That which nourished, sustained and sanctified countless of the Churches' faithful throughout the centuries can not simply be considered as pernicious to the faith and requiring banishment. For one pope to undo what a previous pope has established as eternally valid is akin to one president issuing executive decree to reverse policy of his predecessor. Accordingly then, his successor may similarly, in turn, do likewise. This is dangerous and scandalous towards the Catholic faith. The binding and unbinding of the keys was not meant to rewrite traditional liturgy and morality to fit current cultural trends. Something wild has been unleashed and it has many people talking and praying for the state of the Church.

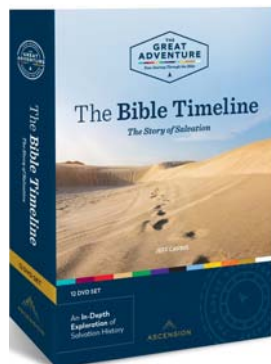

UNPACKING THE CREED
