On May 2, the Church honours the memory of St. Athanasius of Alexandria – a 4th century doctor of the Church who valiantly defended the orthodoxy of Christ's full divinity and full humanity against the prevailing error of the day. He was credited with the title of "the hammer of heretics" as he, at times, stood alone in his fidelity where other bishops adopted heresy. His name sake, the cited Bishop Schneider, is quickly gaining the credibility of being as equally valiant. He grew up under Soviet rule. He holds vivid memories of living under persecution and the heroic efforts of his grandparents, parents, and fellow Catholics who hid priests, gathered secretly in prayer, and risked their lives to hold on to and propagate worship in Jesus Christ and his teachings. His outspoken stances on troubling developments in the Church give him a broad platform and a wide audience that is aching for a prelate to speak boldly and counter-culturally when so many of his fellow clerics are seemingly in lock-step with the ways of the world.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Scott Hahn the well known Catholic theologian mentions in his comments about this weekend's readings that "the curious detail of the charcoal fire" makes a second appearance in the gospel of John. It is the only two places in the New Testament where a charcoal fire is mentioned.

What it does is connect Peter with both events. The first where we are told that he was warming himself after betraying Jesus and the second where Jesus asks him three times, "do you love me" around the charcoal fire. We move here from an act of betrayal to a commitment of love.

It is the very movement of Easter, from sin to eternal life, from death to resurrection. It is an invitation for all of us. The readings place these in the larger context of persecution and suffering. It is by our sufferings, that we will be counted worthy to stand in heaven before "the Lamb that was slain," It is a sober reminder in the midst of Easter Joy that life can be difficult at times. But fear not, our God is with us.
