

homily for the canonization of St. Maria Goretti

The heroic story of St. Maria Goretti's (+1902) refusal to consent, as an 11-year old, to the lewd propositioning of the 20 year Alessandro's aggressive belligerence has been typically used to highlight the value of chastity. That Alessandro, dominated by his lust, erupted into a fit of rage and repeatedly stabbed the young yet valiant girl definitely illustrates the ugliness of obstinately refusing to curb one's libidinous passions. The contrast between her subsequent suffering for and forgiving of her assailant vs his narcissistic self-pitying and his blaming her for his murderous crime further conveys the triumph of grace over sin. It was this sacrificial pleading on Maria Goretti's part in the agonizing hours leading to her death that eventually led to Alessandro's repentance and conversion. For a pornified culture, her noble witness points towards the inevitable glorified victory and promised restoration for those who entrust God in adversity with the cause of their life.


