The rallying cry of "Crux Ave, Spes Unica," signifying very much the heart of our Christian faith, is attributed to an ancient 6th century Latin hymn. On this Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross, together with saints and sinners spanning the centuries, we hail this instrument of Our Lord's Passion as our only hope. This past summer was dubbed as a time of rage; the forecast for the fall season has us bracing for further austerity and hardship. Rising costs at the grocery store and petro pumps are forcing the average citizen into leaner and stricter comfort margins. Further dire warnings of endless booster rounds. Reemergence of virulent variants, a potential return to the dreadful and punitive lockdowns, a nonnegotiable social-score credit-rating digitized system threatens to collapse the coping defenses of us all. Attempts at all public opposition towards dubious policies have already been suppressed by heavy-handed financial penalties. Every dystopian novel of the past seems to be eerily accurate in their prophetic predictions.

From a Christian perspective, unmistakable rupture lines have emerged in society and within the Church. What was once considered traditional Catholicism as documented in catechisms and ecclesial documents all seem open to radical re-interpretation to accommodate and appease aggressive secular ideologies. The world must pass under the shadow of the Cross either willingly and confidently or defiantly and bitterly. Scripture reminds us that the Cross is a scandal to the non-believer. We renew our faith in Christ as triumphant victor and recognize that only when humanity acknowledges his sovereign reign can creation function in right order and rest in tranquility. While the world seems terribly far from such a confession of faith, the cited quote offers hope towards the vanquishing of all that is evil and the illumination of all consciences to the promise of salvation.

Our readings this weekend focus on the sin of Idolatry. It is perhaps the most powerful sin, the one from which others originate. When we think of idols we tend to think of statues and handmade objects worshipped by people in ancient days.

But our modern idols bear no resemblance to those things. Our idols today are more sophisticated. Today many have replaced the "golden calf" of Exodus with an insatiable drive for money, success or prestige in the eyes of the world. Some seek after comfort of a myriad other empty pursuits. Some even worship themselves.

An idol is anything that replaces God in our heart such as possessions, careers, relationships, hobbies, sports, entertainment, goals, greed, addictions to alcohol/drugs/gambling/pornography, etc.

Some of these things are bad in themselves, but some are good. They become a sin when we give them all our time and attention. We believe they will bring us happiness, the happiness only God can give.

The things of this world will never fully satisfy the human heart. They were never meant to. The sinful things deceive us and ultimately lead only to death ([Romans 6:23](#)). The good things of this world are gifts from God, meant to be enjoyed with a thankful heart, in submission to Him and for His glory.

Let us pray for the right attitude towards the things of this world.

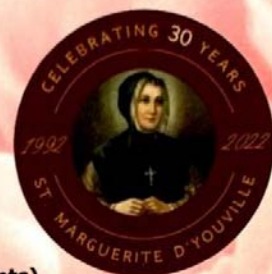
