Born in the West African Country of Guinea, June 15, 1945, by his own recollections, Cardinal Sarah enjoyed and benefited from the very best of missionary efforts. As an enthusiastic and attentive boy, he was fascinated by the mystery that surrounded the Christian priests and nuns that opened up fascinating horizons of education and worship. Ordained a priest at the age of 24, sent to biblical studies in Rome and Jerusalem, Cardinal Sarah was appointed as Archbishop of his native diocese of Conarky, at age 34, during a turbulent period of marxist governmental oppression of the Church's pastoral work. He was on a hit-list for assassination. In the midst of the heavy responsibilities of his office, he grew in ecclesial experience and paternal maturity. He was called to serve in the Curia, at the Holy See, in important assignments under the pontificates of John Paul II, Benedict XVI, and Francis until his retirement.

Now in his venerable elderly years, he reflects back upon the decades of ministry. On this first Sunday of Advent, his insights serve as an honest and sobering appeal to all members of the Church to view their lives in light of final judgment. With a gospel reading that urges us to be attentive to the unknown time of having to render an account of our lives, Cardinal Robert Sarah provides us with a rare voice within the Church – one that unabashedly indicts those entrusted with leadership for having been too timid in preaching the fullness of the gospel demands.

Wayne Manne had this to say "we have grown in our awareness of what it means to be a parish community founded in the spirit of St. Marguerite."

Today, 30 years later, these two challenges still face us. How can we be church in this rapidly expanding, ethnically diverse district of north Brampton noted for young immigrant families, while at the same time remaining true to the spirit of our founder?

As we look forward may St. Marguerite support our efforts with her prayers and guide us in her spirit of dedication and devotion to the poor.
