O Lord Jesus Christ, the true Light that enlightens every man who comes into this world: pour forth Your blessing + upon these candles and sanctify + them with the light of Your grace, and mercifully grant, that as these lights, enkindled with visible fire, dispel the darkness of night, so our hearts, being illumined by invisible fire, that is, by the radiance of the Holy Spirit, may be delivered from the blindness of all vice; that, the eye of our mind being cleansed, we may be able to discern those things that are pleasing to You and profitable to our salvation so that after the perilous darkness of this world we may deserve to attain to never-failing light: Through You, Christ Jesus, Saviour of the world, Who in perfect Trinity, live and reign, God, world without end. Amen.

- Blessing of Candles, Feast of the Presentation, Roman Rite, 1959

One can not be blamed, at this point of the winter season, if longing for spring time unavoidably wells up from deep within. Apart from being the Feast of the Presentation, February 2<sup>nd</sup> is has also become synonymous with the subpar cultural observation of Ground Hog Day. As custom holds, if the plumpy rodent does not see his shadow because of rainy and cloudy conditions, winter's end is imminent. From the secular to the sacred, the gospel proclaims that Christ Child is "a light for revelation to the Gentiles and for glory to your people Israel." (Lk 2.32) Consequently, an important contrast unfolds of competing focus for our hope...whether in the signs of light or shadow. In fact, there is strong suggestion that Ground Hog day was originated in mock contempt to the traditional celebration of the Presentation – a solemn public procession of the faithful with candles lit and blessed before the "Candlemas." What was once a major liturgical feast has been significantly diminished; our contemporary cultural context is unfamiliar with and unskilled at such purposeful manifestations of faith and devotion. Rightfully then, in "the perilous darkness of this world" we pray God's assistance to guard resolutely the flickering flame of fire-tried hearts.

This weekend Jesus as the son of God goes to the mountain top. There he preaches God's message of salvation in the form of the Beatitudes. The Beatitudes mark the fulfillment of God's covenant promise to Abraham—that through his descendants all the nations of the world would receive God's blessings.



Jesus is the son of Abraham. And through the wisdom He speaks today, He bestows the Father's blessings upon "the poor in spirit." God has chosen to bless the weak and lowly, those foolish and despised in the eyes of the world, Paul says in today's Epistle. The poor in spirit are those who know that nothing they do can merit God's mercy and grace. These are the humble remnant in today's First Reading, taught to seek refuge in the name of the Lord.

The Beatitudes reveal the divine path and purpose for our lives. All our striving should be for these virtues—to be poor in spirit; meek and clean of heart; merciful and makers of peace; seekers of the righteousness that comes from living by the law of Kingdom.

The path the Lord sets before us today is one of trials and persecution. But He promises comfort in our mourning and a great reward. The Kingdom we have inherited is no earthly territory but the promised land of heaven. It is Zion where the Lord reigns forever. And, as we sing in today's Psalm, its blessings are for those whose hope is in the Lord. God Bless
