Your lamb shall be without blemish, a year-old male; you may take it from the sheep or from the goats. You shall keep it until the fourteenth day of this month; then the whole assembled congregation of Israel shall slaughter it at twilight. They shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and the lintel of the houses in which they eat it. The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and no plague shall destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.

Exodus 12. 5-6,13, The First Passover Instituted

As we enter into Holy Week, recalling God's far reaching plan of salvation, with its ancient prefigurements, helps us to appreciate how careful and methodical Our Lord is in defeating evil. The lamb of the Passover deliberately anticipates the culminating perfect sacrifice of the Son as the two unfold and are venerated this sacred week simultaneously. The essential key for the Hebrews was to trust the message that Moses was sharing and perform the blood ritual in precise detail. Obedience in the spiritual order would result in deliverance in reality.

One of the chilling dramas that surfaces during Holy Week is the betrayal of Judas. As we shall hear in the gospel readings throughout the week, his stealing and conniving, known to Jesus, are brought to light when Judas thought all was carefully concealed. We hear Jesus appeal to Judas during the Last Supper when he offers him the piece of bread dipped in the dish; subsequently, "Satan entered into him." (Jn 13.27) The same mystery of disobedience in the spiritual realm opens the door to the slaughter of the lamb in the temporal order.

Let us honour this sacred week and our retelling of so great a sacrifice by preparing our hearts with the fruits of fitting repentance and adoration. The innocent victim is shown to be in the right, and the demonstration of that witness shakes the fabric of the cosmos and all its corrupt institutions to the core.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

We have reached the climax of the liturgical year, the highest point of salvation history, when all that has been anticipated and promised is to be fulfilled.

By the close of today's long Gospel, the work of our redemption will have been accomplished: the new covenant will be written in the blood of His broken body hanging on the Cross at the place called the Skull.

In His Passion, Jesus is "counted among the wicked," as Isaiah had foretold. He is revealed definitively as the Suffering Servant the prophet announced, the long-awaited Messiah whose words of obedience and faith ring out in today's First Reading and Psalm.

The taunts and torments we hear in these two readings punctuate the Gospel as Jesus is beaten and mocked, as His hands and feet are pierced, as enemies gamble for His clothes, and as His enemies dare Him to prove His divinity by saving Himself from suffering.

He remains faithful to God's will to the end. He does not turn back in His trial. He gives Himself freely to His torturers, confident that, as He speaks in today's First Reading, "The Lord God is My help. I shall not be put to shame." Amen.




