If you would like more information email Margaret at dyouvilleyouth@gmail.com Where parishes are too large and impersonal, they install small communities in which the individual feels known, appreciated, loved and given a meaning-ful role. Where lay people or women feel marginalized, they assign leadership roles to them. Where the sacred liturgy is celebrated in a cold and routine manner, they celebrate religious services marked by crowd participation, punctuated with shouts of "alleluia" and "Jesus is the Lord", and interspersed with scriptural phrases. Where inculturation is still in its hesitating stages, the New Religious Movements (NRMs) give an appearance of indigenous religious groups which seem to the people as locally rooted. Where homilies are intellectually above the heads of the people, the NRMs urge personal commitment to Jesus Christ and strict and literal adherence to the Bible. Where the Church seems presented too much as an institution marked by structures and hierarchy, the NRMs stress personal relationship with God. No one can doubt that the NRMs show palpable dynamism.

The sparkling and brilliant Nigerian raised Cardinal became the youngest bishop in the world at the time of his ordination and the first African Cardinal to head a Vatican office. Under the papacies of Pope JP II and Benedict XVIth, his love for the liturgy and the properly ordered worship owed to God had him rightly placed in the Congregation for Divine Worship and Discipline of the Sacraments. Now at the age of 91, his service to the Church includes contributing his wise and accurate insights gained from decades of fruitful oversight.

On this Feast of Pentecost, Cardinal Arinze's address highlights his awareness of how evangelical groups can pose a serious challenge to Catholics throughout the world. While warning of the luring elements that can entice poorly formed Catholics to be attracted to their "charismatic" appeal, Cardinal Arinze emphasizes the deep and rich reservoir that sound Catholic doctrine and spirituality have to offer. Ultimately, Cardinal Arinze highlights that as traditional Catholic devotion is suppressed, the door is left open for foreign influences to creep in to our own Catholic parishes where we begin to look increasingly less like the faith of our ancestors and adopt more towards Protestant trends. An ongoing and receptive disposition to the Holy Spirit is needed by the Church hierarchy and her members to best discern where our Lord is leading us.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The giving of the Spirit to the new people of God crowns the mighty acts of the Father in salvation history. The Jewish feast of Pentecost called all devout Jews to Jerusalem to celebrate their birth as God's chosen people in the covenant Law given to Moses at Mt Sinai.



The Spirit is revealed as the life-giving breath of the Father, the Wisdom by which He made all things, as we sing in today's Psalm. In the beginning, the Spirit came as a "mighty wind" sweeping over the face of the earth . And in the new creation of Pentecost, the Spirit again comes as "a strong, driving wind" to renew the face of the earth.

As God fashioned the first man out of dust and filled him with His Spirit, in today's Gospel we see the New Adam become a life-giving Spirit, breathing new life into the Apostles.

Like a river of living water, for all ages He will pour out His Spirit on His body, the Church, as we hear in today's Epistle.

We receive that Spirit in the sacraments, being made a "new creation" in Baptism. Drinking of the one Spirit in the Eucharist, we are the first fruits of a new humanity—fashioned from out of every nation under heaven, with no distinctions of wealth or language or race, a people born of the Spirit.


