

How is it dear family that we have so much chaos in the world? How is it then that we have so much chaos in the Catholic Church? Family...connect the dots. When you see disorder, when you see chaos, know and understand that the shepherds are not doing the will of Our Father...Keep the faith, dear family, keep the faith no matter what because we know in the end that Christ conquers. Keep the faith. Follow the will of Our Father in heaven even when you don't see it, when you only see chaos in the world and in so many Catholic churches, persevere until the end. Fr. Fr. James Altman rose to international prominence when, in the build up to the 2020 American elections, he preached zealously that a Catholic in good standing could not vote for the Democrat platform. The local bishop from his diocese of Madison, Wisconsin, subsequently removed Fr. Altman from his parish of St. James the Less 2 years ago, at this time of year when parish moves typically occur. While still pursuing the canonical grounds of his suspension, Fr. James Altman has not let up on his outspoken criticism of the Churches' hierarchy drawing attention to the bishops' complicity in vaccine mandates, support of pro-abortion politicians, and ineffectiveness in countering the gender confusion being sown everywhere. His confrontational tone has been deemed unwelcomed.

Nonetheless, Fr. James Altman is respected by many Catholics who welcome his boldness. The priesthood is intended to help establish Christ's sovereign and divinely ordered reign in our lives. Where that order is respected, the human family flourishes rather than the utter chaos and force-fed toxic mayhem of which we have all been exposed. On a Father's day weekend, we give thanks to the strength that our human and spiritual fathers offer in providing all the natural and supernatural means of structuring our lives in harmony with God's will.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

In the Church, we have been gathered as the new "Israel of God". He has made us His own people, the flock He tends, as we sing in today's Psalm. Moses was Israel's first shepherd. With the Promised Land in view, he prayed that God would raise up a succes-



sor so that God's people would not be left as sheep without a shepherd. These same words are used in today's Gospel to describe Jesus' pity for the crowds, who are "troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd."

Israel's shepherds—the Pharisees and scribes—had abandoned and misled the people through their hypocrisy and spiritual blindness. But God had long before promised that He Himself would come and save His sheep—searching over the whole earth where they had been scattered "for lack of a shepherd"

Jesus is the new Moses and new David promised by the prophets, a divine shepherd-king sent to restore God's priestly kingdom. As Moses commissioned Joshua as his successor, so we see Jesus today giving the Twelve His powers and authority. In God's plan, they are to seek out the lost sheep of Israel first and then bring all nations into the fold.

Together we have been saved and reconciled to God, as we hear in today's Epistle. As He delivered Israel, He has also made us a kingdom of priests in the Church.

So we come in this Mass to serve Him with gladness, to praise His kindness, which endures forever.


