The cited quote, taken from her highly acclaimed, "Fighting for Life: Becoming a Force for Change in a Wounded World" is a good indication of Lila's firm conviction and clarity of thought as to the unfathomable inadmissibility of believing that there is a moral/legal right to ending a preborn child's life. Lila Rose, born in 1998, originally from the ultra-progressive city of San Francisco, was home-schooled along with her 7 siblings in a Christian home. Her diligent study of the faith led her to an Opus Dei community on the campus of UCLA and her initiation into the Catholic Church. Since the age of 15, she has been working to promote the cause of life and advocacy for women to have better options than the false promise of abortion. She has taken direct aim at Planned Parenthood clinics through the organization she founded. "Live Action." Her hidden videos have exposed the illegal practices of so many clinics: posing as an underage teen, she has captured footage of how readily willing abortion providers were willing to not report on cited details of abuse and prostitution of minors so as to carry out their "services."

As the 1 year anniversary of the overturning of Roe vs. Wade has taken the abortion debate back to the state level, the splitting of opinion on the killing of children has pushed abortion advocates to even further dangerous extremes. And so, articulate, intelligent, attractive, fearless defenders of life, such as Lila Rose, are needed everywhere.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Our commitment to Christ will be put to the test. We will hear whispered warnings and denunciations, as Jeremiah does in today's First Reading. Even so-called

friends will try to trap and trip us up. For His sake we will bear insults and be made outcasts—even in our own homes, we hear in today's Psalm.

As Jeremiah tells us, we must expect that God will challenge our faith in Him, and probe our minds and hearts, to test the depths of our love. "Do not be afraid," Jesus assures us three times in today's Gospel.

Though He may permit us to suffer for our faith, our Father will never forget or abandon us. As Jesus assures us today, everything unfolds in His providence, under His watchful gaze—even the falling of the tiniest sparrow to the ground. Each one of us is precious to Him. Steadfast in this faith, we must resist the tactics of Satan. He is the enemy who seeks the ruin of our soul in hell.

We are to seek God, as the Psalmist says. Zeal for the Lord's house, for the heavenly kingdom of the Father, should consume us, as it consumed Jesus. As Jesus bore the insults of those who blasphemed God, so should we.
