

-Stanzas 3 & 4 of, "O Little Town of Bethlehem"


As the warmth, memories, and nostalgia for Christmas pasts and present lay before us, favoured carols certainly enhance this liturgical time. The backstory of the composition of this cherished carol adds to its likability. It was composed by an American pastor, originally from the Boston era. The Rev. Phillips Brooks (1835-1893) looked more the part of a football player than preacher. Standing six feet four inches tall and weighing in at 300 pounds, his hulking, handsome stature was complimented with a keen intelligence. His education at the Harvard Divinity School, at a time when the prestigious institution earned its famed reputation as a place of brilliant scholarship, had him master not only studies into Sacred Scripture, but he became fluent in Greek, Latin, French and German. When his formidable presence took to the pulpit, he commanded attention with a striking contrast of booming voice and genuine, gentle Christian demeanor.

In the summer of 1868, he traveled to the Holy Land. He so marveled at the sacred sites, that upon his return, he too, like so many who have visited, saw the gospels come alive having seen the geography and landscapes where all had taken place. As Christmas drew near, he penned the words to "O Little Town of Bethlehem" as an inspired tribute to his pilgrim meditations. He pressed the organist at his parish in the lead up to Christmas morning to compose a corresponding melody. A Christmas classic came to birth.

With less than 100 km of distance separating the town of Bethlehem from the Gaza strip, how urgent our prayer is for the Messiah, the Prince of Peace, to be known, proclaimed, confessed, and worshiped by all peoples in so troubled a time as ours.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

What is announced to Mary in today's Gospel is the revelation of all that the prophets had spoken. It is, as Paul declares in today's Epistle, the mystery kept secret since before the foundation of the world.





Mary is hailed as the "daughter Jerusalem," called to rejoice that her king, the Lord God, has come into her midst as a mighty savior.

The One whom Mary is to bear will be Son of "the Most High"—an ancient divine title first used to describe the God of the priest-king Melchizedek, who brought out bread and wine to bless Abraham at the dawn of salvation history.

He will fulfill the covenant God makes with His chosen one, David, in today's First Reading. As we sing in today's Psalm, He will reign forever as highest of the kings of the earth, and He will call God "my Father." As Daniel saw the Most High grant everlasting dominion to the Son of Man, His kingdom will have no end.

He is to rule over the house of Jacob—the title God used in making His covenant with Israel at Sinai, and again used in promising that all nations would worship the God of Jacob.

Jesus has been made known, Paul says today, to bring all nations to the obedience of faith. We are called with Mary today to marvel at all that the Lord has done throughout the ages for our salvation. And we too must respond to this annunciation with humble obedience—that His will be done, that our lives be lived according to His word.
