With parents professionally trained and steeped in classical music composition and conducting, she earned degrees in legal philosophy having studied and worked in Utrecht/Netherlands, Munich/Germany, and in Brussels/Belgium. Eva has been a sought after voice by pundits such as Tucker Carlson and Mark Steyn reaching audiences beyond her northern European circle to include North America, Scandinavia and Great Britain. # FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

We focus this liturgical year of Mark's gospel and this weekend we transition from the theme of discipleship to that of the kingdom of God. The first thing that you must remember is that the Kingdom of God is not a place. The Kingdom of God is where God reigns. And where God reigns is where the Kingdom of God is.



So the first place you look, of course, is in your own

heart. For Jesus when he comes he says, "The Kingdom of God is among you. The Kingdom of God is at the door. The Kingdom of God is within vou."

So Mark will give you, in the next four weeks, four stories that, for him, out of the many, many, many incidents in Christ's life, these four stories will be able to help you understand when Mark says the Kingdom of God he means the Kingdom of God is Jesus himself. It is the presence of Jesus among us, the presence of the Christos, the Holy One of God, who walks with us as surely now as he did all those hundreds of years ago.

Jesus goes from place to place. And every place he goes there's a purpose for going there. And what he says, there's a purpose for what he says there. But, most of all, what he does is what makes you fully understand and realize this is not the ordinary itinerant preacher that the people of Capernaum were blessed to hear that day.

Mark tells us that when he spoke they were astonished. It's more important to know that the crowd was astonished than what Jesus said. Why? Because Jesus is the Kingdom of God and when he spoke he spoke direct to the heart and he touched them and he moved them in ways that none of the ancient books and none of the old rabbis and none of the eloquent men in from Jerusalem all the way up to Capernaum ever spoke before.

And they just were in awe, because this was a man who spoke with authority. Today let us open our hears that he may speak to us with authori-Fr. Roger
