You threaten me with a fire that burns for a season, and after a little while is quenched; but you are ignorant of the fire of everlasting punishment that is prepared for the wicked."

St. Polycarp Bishop, (69-155), Feast Day, Feb 23

At the start of Lent, the venerable witness of this Church Father can provide us with inspiration to build up our penitential resolve. The test that this bishop of the ancient Roman coastal city of Smyrna (modern day Turkey along the Aegean Sea) was to simply offer a pinch of incense to be offered to the pagan gods. He categorically refused on account of not wanting to scandalize younger believers by cowardly betraying his faith. Rightfully, St. Polycarp is a model for Christian clergy and laity spanning the ensuing centuries.

And so, St. Polycarp challenges us to discern wisely the distinction of authentic positions and strategies in confronting social policies. It ought to be our Catholic goal to want to be in solidarity to all that a government proposes that truly advances the common good. When policies that are in flagrant violation of natural law and sacred revealed truth are promoted, we are called to provide courageous and righteous opposition, while still voicing our intent of upholding valid laws. In contrast, defeatist positions to morally repugnant policies can be seen when the faithful choose to either conform or avoid taking any public stance. Quiet acquiescence or retreating from any difficult social stance is precisely what a St. Polycarp deemed to be unworthy of the sacred responsibilities assigned to him. We pray for such robust and noble Church leadership in our own times.

#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Lent bids us to return to the innocence our baptism. As Noah and his family were saved through the waters of the deluge, we were saved through the waters of Baptism, Peter reminds us in today's Epistle.



And God's covenant with Noah in today's First MR Reading marked the start of a new world. But it also

prefigured a new and greater covenant between God and His creation.

We see that new covenant and that new creation begin in today's Gospel. Jesus is portrayed as the new Adam—the beloved son of God, living in harmony with the wild beasts, being served by angels. Like Adam, He too is tempted by the devil. But while Adam fell, giving reign to sin and death, Jesus is victorious. This is the good news, the "gospel of God" that He proclaims. Through His death, resurrection, and enthronement at the right hand of the Father, the world is once again made God's kingdom.

In the waters of Baptism, each of us entered the kingdom of His beloved Son. We were made children of God, new creations. But like Jesus, and Israel before Him, we have passed through the baptismal waters only to be driven into the wilderness—a world filled with afflictions and tests of our faithfulness.

We are led on this journey by Jesus. He is the Savior—the way and the truth we sing of in today's Psalm. He feeds us with the bread of angels, and cleanses our consciences in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

As we begin this holy season, let us renew our baptismal vows—to repent and believe the gospel.
