

If you will give me victory over my enemies, and if I may have evidence of that miraculous power which the people dedicated to your name say that they have experienced, then I will believe in you and I will be baptized in your name. I have called upon my own gods, but, as I see only too clearly, they have no intention of helping me. I therefore cannot believe that they possess any power, for they do not come to the assistance of those who trust in them. I now call upon you. I want to believe in you, but I must first be saved from my ene-

As for those in the Catholic world still determined to do reparation for the sacrilege that occurred at the opening of the Olympic Ceremony, part of the penance is to plead for France's return as "eldest daughter" of the Church. Part of that intercessory effort is to try and filtrate out the toxic ideologies that have corrupted France's glorious sacred past. The cited quote signifies an epic turning point of Catholicism's acceptance by a powerful ruling family. Prior to King Clovis' conversion, the soul of France was contested for by heroic missionary efforts of some notable figures: St. Irenaeus (martyred in Lyon, +130), St. Denis (first bishop of Paris, beheaded at Montmartre +250), St. Hillary (doctor of the Church who defended the faith against arian heresy in Poitier, +367) St. Martin (Roman soldier converted and became abbot/bishop in Tours, +397). With King Clovis (baptized by St. Remy[of fine brandy]), and his successors, the Church in France was granted protection to carry out her divine mission that admirably transformed the nation as we now know it. For example, King Clovis' son Childébert invited the Benedictines to establish a monastery to help advise the imperial court and provide a resting place for the tombs of the Clovis kings. The name of the abbey and Church eventually took on the name of the noble Bishop of Paris, (St. Germanus, +576), who oversaw the ecclesial effort. The abbey is located on the "left bank" of the river Seine, directly across from the Louvre Museum. Nearby Notre Dame cathedral would not begin construction until the 12th century. The whole neighborhood carries the memory of these events in the local football stadium where PSG competes. There would be no Paris Saint Germain if not for the string of providential historical episodes that define the best of French history and culture.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

In today's Gospel, the Pharisees try to trap Jesus with a trick question.



Divorce violates the order of creation, He says. Moses permitted it only as a concession to the people's "hardness of heart"—their inability to live by God's covenant Law. But Jesus comes to fulfill the Law, to reveal its true meaning and purpose, and to give people the grace to keep God's commands.

Marriage, He reveals, is a sacrament, a divine, life-giving sign. Through the union of husband and wife, God intended to bestow His blessings on the human family—making it fruitful, multiplying it until it filled the earth. That's why today's Gospel moves so easily from a debate about marriage to Jesus' blessing of children. Children are blessings the Father bestows on couples who walk in His ways, as we sing in today's Psalm.

Marriage also is a sign of God's new covenant. As today's Epistle hints, Jesus is the new Adam—made a little lower than the angels, born of a human family. The Church is the new Eve, the "woman" born of Christ's pierced side as He hung in the sleep of death on the Cross.

Through the union of Christ and the Church as "one flesh," God's plan for the world is fulfilled. Eve was "mother of all the living". And in Baptism, we are made sons and daughters of the Church, children of the Father, heirs of the eternal glory He intended for the human family in the begin-

The challenge for us is to live as children of the kingdom, growing up ever more faithful in our love and devotion to the ways of Christ and the teachings of His Church.
