Jesus Christ leads us safely towards the meaning and purpose of our lives, when we shall see God face to face. And the procession of so many thousands of young (and not so young) Christians from Paris to this magnificent cathedral in Chartres symbolically represents the Church's pilgrimage to the heavenly Jerusalem.

In the Holy Eucharist, which we are now celebrating together, the Church sacramentally anticipates the heavenly wedding banquet of all the redeemed with the Lamb of God, who offered Himself up truly and historically for our salvation on the altar of the cross. Both the physical difficulties that we overcame on our pilgrimage and the temptations of the soul and doubts of the heart that we conquered deepen and strengthen the hope of believers that they are on the right path to the Kingdom of God.

Homily from Chartres Pentecost Pilgrimage May 2024,

#### Cardinal Gerhard Müller

Seeking to restore a tradition that dates back over 1000 years, young French Catholics, this weekend, are resolutely taking up an annual 3 day Pentecost pilgrimage walk stretching 80 kms of terrain from Notre Dame in Paris to the equally impressive Cathedral of Chartres. Joined by a consortium of international pilgrims, the twenty thousand plus procession prays and sings their way through small towns and farmers fields. With overnight camping accommodations and simple meals of soup and bread, the physical hardship is shared and embraced by the many who are looking to bulk up in their spiritual strength. The pilgrimage culminates with a high solemn mass celebrated in the Chartres Cathedral that hosts the relic of the Veil of Mary believed to have been worn at the time of the Annunciation and Nativity. A gift from the time of the emperor Charlemagne from the Byzantine Church, it has survived not only the passage of time but even an attack at the time of the Revolution that saw it torn it two. From all accounts, the exuberance and faith shown by the many young participants is even attracting the likes of longtime ecclesial, academically minded clergy like the German born, Gerhard Cardinal Müller. The treasuring of traditional practices of piety and worship as a way of addressing the many crises that Europe faces can certainly be appreciated by any parent who is committed to the daily care of the formation of conscience for their young adolescent child. As the Sacrament of Confirmation is widely celebrated during these days, let us pray that many young Christians will deeply know the abiding presence of the Holy Spirit in their lives sustaining them and guiding them to emerge victorious over all life's adversities.

The giving of the Spirit to the new people of God crowns the mighty acts of the Father in salvation history. The Jewish feast of Pentecost called all devout Jews to Jerusalem to celebrate their birth as God's


