

On a winter's night of January 17, 1871, a remarkable 3 hour occurrence in a small north western village of France had a profound impact on its citizens and impressive reverberations far beyond. France was losing soldiers and territory to the advancing Prussian army. Two village brothers, Joseph and Eugene Barbadette, were finishing their day's chores with their father when a beautiful woman appeared to them. When neither of the boys' parents could see what they were describing, they were ordered inside for dinner. With the boys enraptured, the parents could sense that this phenomenon was more than just their sons' overactive imagination. They summoned for the local school teacher nun who could not see their vision either; however, she had enough sense to invite two other younger students to the scene without offering any explanation as to why. Immediately, the two girls also described in detail that which the boys had reported. Accordingly, the parish priest and the whole village all gathered and began praying the Rosary, litanies and other Marian hymns. While all that was visible to the crowd were three bright golden stars, the children could all see Mary delight in the communal devotion. The cited message then descended from a banner. When the village prayed a penitential psalm, Our Blessed Mother revealed a look of sorrow and a red crucifix appeared in her hand for all to venerate. With a final Marian hymn, her countenance again showed delight and two white crosses appeared on each of her shoulders. Significantly, the scene was also witnessed by the advancing Prussian army and they decided to make their retreat seeing that the Blessed Virgin Mary was protecting the surrounding region. This lesser known Marian mystery deserves broader attention. The grateful town built a beautiful Basilica to not only honour the memory of that incredible evening but as a way of pledging themselves to continue in invoking her protective intercession. As the 3 golden stars encircled her, let us turn to her and ask her help in adoring the glory and majesty of the Most Holy Trinity.

Corpus Christi Mass & Procession – Saint Michael’s Cathedral Basilica


