

In my opinion, those who choose against the traditional understanding of these matters are choosing a deception that only the devil will benefit from, a pernicious presumption on the mercy of God that will encourage countless souls to happily embark on the "broad way" that only leads to destruction. Painful decisions await many of us. It is time to stop straddling the issue. We have to make a choice, for Scripture and tradition or for a "different Gospel."

Dr. Ralph Martin, from his 2020 book, A Church in Crisis: Pathways Forward

As one of the co-founders of Renewal Ministries, Ralph Martin's decades -long contributions to the Church in North America and beyond has been significant. Emerging from the Charismatic movement of the late 1970's and early 80's, Ralph and his team have been promoting the Second Vatican Council's call to holiness among lay people by fully supporting the Churches' mission with obedience and zeal. His conferences and Lift the Jesus Higher rallies have crisscrossed cities all over the world and have touched the lives of clergy and converts alike. Ralph Martin has fortified his theological credentials with his stellar academic career authoring numerous important work's (The Fulfillment of all Desire, Will Many Be Saved, The Final Confrontation) and is also known through his media appearances on EWTN or his various podcasts. Consequently, the choice made by the Bishop of Detroit to remove Dr. Martin, a tenured and credible professor, from the Sacred Heart Seminary in Detroit (as well as two others) has left many scratching their heads in bewilderment. The reason cited by the Bishop was on account of concerns regarding Martin's "theological perspective." To his credit, Dr. Ralph Martin has accepted the termination with grace and Providential trust, not wanting to further escalate schismatic tensions. The outward appearance of purging traditionally minded faithful souls is yet another troubling sign of the times for the life of the Church.

Paul encourages us to be bold in our Christian living because the spirit we have been given is a spirit of boldness and not timidity. Such an exhortation is difficult and not easily fulfilled.

Most of us prefer to avoid confrontation at all cost especially when it makes others uncomfortable. There was a time when for instance the church used to dwell too much on fearing God, but I wonder whether we have now gone in the opposite direction.

We have become timid and too keen to be liked. So the message of Christianity and our Christian living is ruled by the desire to be politically correct. We do not want to offend so either we say nothing or we couch our language in soft, timid words. Paul suggests in 2nd Timothy, our reading for this weekend, that

Paul suggests in 2nd Timothy, our reading for this weekend, that there are times when we simply need to speak out and call a spade a spade, and if this means instilling a sense of "fear of the Lord" in others, then so be it. After all it is one of the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit.

It is an acknowledgement that God expects something of us. That we must answer to God. The truth is that we are not in charge. God is. Sometimes we need this fact plainly stated.

Let is therefore fan into flame the gift of God, a gift that must be lived boldly and courageously.




ST. MARGUERITE D'YOUVILLE NOVENA
