

Is it not worrying in itself that European Christianity is now barely able to keep Europe Christian? If we lose sight of this, the idea of Europe could become a minority interest in its own continent.

The Honourable Mr. Viktor Orban, Prime Minister of Hungary

The scriptural readings during the second and third weeks of Advent present us with the prophetic voice of John the Baptist. John's clear and urgent mission was to prepare people for the imminent coming of the Messiah. Amid all the political and social conflicts of his day, St. John's message was an uncomplicated invitation to return back to covenantal fidelity through repentance. Accordingly, the life and times of Viktor Orban interestingly parallels the Baptist's mandate, in an unexpected manner. Viktor is the result of Soviet culture. Born in 1963, he had little use or regard for religion. His academic entrance into law and politics focused more on the individual rights of free citizens that suffered suffocation under communist rule. As a result of his longtime public service, his insight and appreciation into the role of Christianity has substantially deepened. It is commonly recognized that to be a true student of history will lead one to authentic faith and acknowledge the Catholic Churches' vital contribution in building up civilization. To reverse the decline and despondency of generations that grew up without worship or catechesis, Viktor Orban is a strong defender of traditional Catholicism. He has activated strong financial incentives to help young couples start families, own homes, encouraging them to have numerous children. Mr. Orban believes that the future belongs to those who show up for it. Consequently, he has drawn his share of detractors and enemies. Viktor Orban does not want to surrender his country to the Islamifying trends of mass migration that has dramatically altered other European countries. Moreover, he has offered vigorous opposition to other pernicious trends that are imposed upon his citizens from outside sources such as the European Union or from the scurrilous meddling of billionaire elites such as Hungary's own, George Soros. Viktor Orban's noble fight for the present and future of his country by calling his fellow citizens to the glories of Hungary's history and Catholic identity very much make him a John the Baptist-like voice crying out to make ready the way.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

"The kingdom of heaven is at hand," John proclaims. And the Liturgy today paints us a vivid portrait of our new king and the shape of the kingdom He has come to bring.



He will be the Messiah, anointed with the Holy Spirit (see 2) Samuel 23:1; 1 Kings 1:39; Psalm 2:2), endowed with the seven gifts of the Spirit—wisdom, understanding, counsel, strength, knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord.

He will rule with justice, saving the poor from the ruthless and wicked. His rule will be not only over Israel—but will extend from sea to sea, to the ends of the earth. He will be a light, a signal to all nations. And they will seek Him and pay Him homage.

John delivers this same message in the Gospel. Once God's chosen people were hewn from the rock of Abraham (see Isaiah 51:1–2). Now, God will raise up living stones (see 1 Peter 2:5)—children of Abraham born not of flesh and blood but of the Spirit.

God bless our hearts in this advent season. May we live up to our calling as followers of Christ!
