The ripple effect of evangelization that Our Lady of Guadalupe unleashed upon the Indigenous peoples of Central and South America is incomparable to any other missionary success in the history of the Church. From the stunning and miraculous image of Juan Diego's tilma of 1532, devotion to Our Blessed Mother radiated throughout the Spanish speaking world. Most particularly at this time, the "Senora de Candelaria" is celebrated with fervor in cities of: Quito in Ecuador, Diriomo in Nicaragua, Medellin in Colombia, Mayaguez, in Puerto Rico, Jocoro in El Salvador, Puno in Peru, Copacabana in Bolivia. What each festival has in common is a procession to honour our Blessed Mother with a locally carved statue beautifully adorned; she is exquisitely embroidered in dresses and robes that reflect the local peoples and culture. The elegant regalia acknowledges and venerates her maternal sacrifice of already knowing the sacrificial fate of her son and her sorrow piercing participation in the suffering to come as revealed in the accompanying gospel story. The extensive festivities have far reaching appeal. Notably, for all the pageantry that is involved in the Miss Universe evening gown display, the Brazilian contestant robed herself in a veil that suitably reflected her devotion to Our Lady of Aparacida; the contestant winner modestly presented herself throughout the competition while not hiding her affection for La Morena. A proper appreciation of Marian devotion offers great benefits to promoting a dignified, viable femininity and its ensuing connection to the worlds of female health, fitness, fashion and career. In contrast to a feminism that is either plagued by conflict, resentment, and bitterness or where women are otherwise presented as hyper-seductive vixens, the Our Lady of Candelaria celebrations remind European and North American Catholic counterparts of a venerable heritage highly to be treasured and applauded.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

This weekend Jesus as the son of God goes to the mountain top. There he preaches God's message of salvation in the form of the Beatitudes. The Beatitudes mark the fulfillment of God's covenant promise to Abraham—that through his descendants all the nations of the world would receive God's blessings. Jesus is the son of Abraham. And through the wisdom He speaks today, He bestows the Father's blessings upon "the poor in spirit."

God has chosen to bless the weak and lowly, those foolish and despised in the eyes of the world, Paul says in today's Epistle. The poor in spirit are those who know that nothing they do can merit God's mercy and grace. These are the humble remnant in today's First Reading, taught to seek refuge in the name of the Lord.

The Beatitudes reveal the divine path and purpose for our lives. All our striving should be for these virtues—to be poor in spirit; meek and clean of heart; merciful and makers of peace; seekers of the righteousness that comes from living by the law of Kingdom.

The path the Lord sets before us today is one of trials and persecution. But He promises comfort in our mourning and a great reward.

The Kingdom we have inherited is no earthly territory but the promised land of heaven. It is Zion where the Lord reigns forever. And, as we sing in today's Psalm, its blessings are for those whose hope is in the Lord.

FIRST FRIDAY - HOLY HOUR

Please join us in this holy hour of prayers during the Eucharistic adoration on First Fridays of every month. We start with the 3 O'clock Prayer and the Divine Mercy Chaplet at 3:00pm. Then, we continue with Prayers of Adoration, Thanksgiving, Reparation, and Intercession. We also pray the Eucharistic Rosary and the Litany of the Blessed Sacrament. We end the hour with a hymn of praise and adoration at 4:00pm. All are welcome.
