We have to believe and be sure that nothing is impossible in the eyes of God. If I had to, I would start all over again the same way, walking the same path of difficulties, because faith, which never abandons me, would give me strength to always go forward. My mission is to love, I don't have time to tear others down.

While the Northern hemisphere pushes through the cold heart of winter, pre-Lenten Mardi Gras festivities and Copacabana beach scenes unfold basking in 30+ degree sunshine, sand, and skin. 1500 kms north of Rio de Janeiro, the lesser known Brazilian city of Salvador is similarly situated along the Atlantic coast. Among most Catholics, the even lesser known remarkable life of St. Irma Dulce is an inspiring story to be discovered. When she was just 6 years old, her mother died. Under the guardianship of her aunt, her middle upper class education was also mixed with visits to Brazil's shanty town favelas. At 18, she decided to join the Franciscan missionary sisters and took on the name of her deceased mother. Sr. Irma Dulce became the Mother Teresa of Northern Brazil; in fact, they met in 1979. Sr. Irma cared for the disabled and discarded in an abandoned building. When attention was drawn to her charitable operation given the mounting interest of those in pitiful need, the absentee landlord stepped in to evict the squatters who took residence in the makeshift shelter. Sr. Irma Dulce eventually made do with the chicken coop attached to her convent to welcome in the city's poor and infirm and converted it into a viable hospital. She sustained her works of mercy through begging and advocacy. Moreover, her pastoral efforts also included education to her beloved guests and social organizing. Given Brazil's controversial and infamous history of flirting with Marxist principles of "liberation theology," Sr. Irma's work contributed greatly to the delicate balance of the Churches' preferential option for the poor without fomenting class conflict and violent public uprisings. That important discernment is still ongoing within the Church, especially given the severe 1917 warnings that Our Blessed Mother revealed about the danger of communism. As an encouraging sign for Brazil's future, this past November 2025, a 54 metre high statue of Our Lady of Fatima was inaugurated in the relatively proximate city of Crato, Brazil. Similarly, the Central American city of San Salvador, which also has known its battles with divisiveness of liberation theology, will soon have an impressive Gothic-style basilica dedicated to Our Lady of Fatima. Pastoral care that incorporates faithfully the Churches' full teaching of Catholic social doctrine is a goal that needs to be studied and implemented everywhere.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Jesus came among us as light to scatter the darkness of a fallen world. As His disciples, we too are called to be "the light of the world," He tells us in the Gospel this Sunday. Israel was given the mission of being a light to the nations, that God's salvation would reach to the ends of the earth. The liturgy shows us this week that the Church, and every Christian, is called to fulfill Israel's mission.

By our faith and good works we are to make the light of God's life break forth in the darkness, as we sing in this week's Psalm. This week's readings remind us that our faith can never be a private affair, something we can hide as if under a basket.

We are to pour ourselves out for the afflicted, as Isaiah tells us in the First Reading. Our light must shine as a ray of God's mercy for all who are poor, hungry, naked, and enslaved.

There must be a transparent quality to our lives. Our friends and family, our neighbors and fellow citizens, should see reflected in us the light of Christ and through us be attracted to the saving truths of the Gospel.

So let us pray that we, like St. Paul in the Epistle, might proclaim with our whole lives "Christ, and him crucified."
