There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish. But what are they among so many people?

- Solemnity of Corpus Christi, John 6.9

On the Feast of Our Lord's Body and Blood, the gospel selections for the 3 year cycle illuminate this most sacred, inexhaustible mystery: the Eucharist as True Presence, the Institution of the Eucharist and its perpetuation of the Sacrifice of Calvary, or the Eucharistic feast as anticipation of the heavenly banquet and overflowing source of divine communion. The paradox of having already received revelation in abundance beyond comprehension and yet still straining forward to be sustained in sufficiency leads us to identify with the predicament of the Apostles and the young boy as cited in the miracle of the multiplication of loaves. Since the Church is invited trustingly to live this tension of feast and famine, the eventual fate of the unnamed boy referenced in the gospel story is worth noting. Christian lore records his name as St. Syrus; he eventually followed St. Peter to Rome and was commissioned to evangelize the north of Italy, toward the Lombard region. St. Syrus died in the city of Pavia, just south of Milan, where his missionary effort met with success and is recognized as the city's first bishop. The diocese of Pavia became so influential as a Catholic theological/cultural centre that the reigning monarch acquired the relics of St. Augustine of Hippo in the 8th century to preserve them from Islamic threat in northern Africa. Saint Syrus' legacy is preserved not only in the veneration of his relics in the cathedral of Pavia, but his name is famously sealed in the world-renowned football stadium of Milan. AC Milan and Inter Milan play in St. Siro Stadium. Moreover, one of St. Syrus' young assistants was aptly named St. Juventius. When a group of young male students formed another iconic football club in the city of Turin in the year 1897, they suitably named their team using the play on words "Juventus." (referring both the word for "youth" in Latin and as a tribute to the region's patron.) In the life-giving gift that is the Eucharist, tracing this fruitful connection allows appreciation of how the spread of the gospel helps form the best of Catholic culture.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



The Eucharist is given to us as a challenge and a promise. That's how Jesus presents it in today's Gospel. He doesn't make it easy for those who hear Him.

They are repulsed and offended at His words. Even when they begin to quarrel, He insists on describing the eating and drinking of His flesh and blood in starkly literal terms.

The heavenly manna was not given to satisfy the Israelites' hunger, as Moses explains. It was given to show them that man does not live by bread alone but by every word that comes from the mouth of God. In today's Psalm, too, we see a connection between God's Word and the bread of life. We sing of God filling us with "finest wheat" and proclaiming His Word to the world.

In Jesus, "the living Father" has given us His Word come down from heaven, made flesh for the life of the world. In the Eucharist we are made one flesh with Christ. We have His life in us and have our life because of Him. This is what Paul means in today's Epistle when he calls the Eucharist a "participation" in Christ's body and blood. We become in this sacrament partakers of the divine nature.

This is the mystery of the faith that Jesus asks us believe. And He gives us His promise: that, sharing in His flesh and blood that was raised from the dead, we too will be raised up on the last day.
